





Minutes of the meeting of the Project Approval Board held on 17th May, 2018 to consider the Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) 2018-19 of Samagra Shiksha for the State of Tamil Nadu

1. INTRODUCTION:

The meeting of the Project Approval Board for considering the Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B), 2018-19 for Samagra Shiksha for the State of Tamil Nadu was held on 17th May, 2018. List of participants in the meeting is at **Annexure-I**.

Shri Maneesh Garg, JS (SE.1) welcomed the participants and the State representatives led by Shri Pradeep Yadav, Secretary, Government of Tamil Nadu and invited them to brief on the initiatives taken by the State.

2. INITIATIVES OF THE STATE

- State has taken initiative for recycling of 50% of textbooks in government schools. State is undertaking the process for monitoring of BRCs/CRCs. The State is planning to provide tablets to more than 30,000 schools for supporting the Shaalakosh initiative of the Department.
- The IEDSS centres at present have the ICT facilities such as magnifiers, JAWS software, flash teacher support for low vision students and angelpro for visually impaired. The centres are provided with all ICT materials which are very useful for the visual and hearing impaired students. The special educators were trained by the NGO and NIVH for handling the instruments for the benefits of the CWSN students in the secondary classes.
- The abstract maths can be learned by the pedagogy – CPA (Concrete, Pictorial, Abstract) in which children learn the maths concepts by doing with concrete objects. The Vikram Sarabai Science Centre provides the necessary material and the Ramanujam Maths & Science Institute provides the necessary kit for the exploration
- IMPART (Improving Participation) is another special initiative designed to improve the participation of students in secondary education. The scheme is implemented in

the special focus districts viz. Cuddalore, Kanchipuram, Nagapattinam, The Nilgiris, Perambalur, Tiruvarur and Villupuram. The best projects of the students are duly awarded in the District Level Science Exhibition.

- Inclusive schools – All RMSA schools which are upgraded by the mission are having the provision of ramp up to second floor and the toilet and other provisions were totally CWSN friendly. 1,254 new schools and 44 model schools have this provision.

3. ACTION TAKEN COMMITMENTS GIVEN BY THE STATE FOR 2017-18

The progress made in implementing the commitments given by the State in 2017-18 was reviewed. The status in respect of some of the major commitments and the comments of the PAB thereon are as follows:-

4. Appraisal issues- 2018-19

Educational Indicators

- Concern was expressed over the considerable decrease in GER and NER at higher secondary level and State was requested to take remedial measures. Regarding decrease in enrolment, State Secretary stated that State has launched a movement for increasing enrolment in government schools and that they will verify the data and share a status note with the Department on reduction in enrolment at elementary and higher secondary level in the academic year 2017-18.
- State was also requested to take immediate action for tackling the issue of zero enrolment schools so as to utilize the resources optimally.

- It was suggested to the State that redeployment of upper primary teachers may be undertaken by the State to maintain the PTR. Also, rationalization of teachers is required in single teacher schools.
- As per the recommendation of the JRM under erstwhile RMSA, activity based/Experiential learning may be promoted in the State to enhance the GER/NER at higher secondary level.
- There is a decrease in enrolment in Govt. and Aided schools (Decrease of 26.79% at primary level, 21.30% at upper primary level, 18.64% at secondary level and 9.08% schools at Hr. secondary level).
- Transition rate from upper primary to secondary is very low in some districts like Thiruvarur (69.83).
- There are 1408 surplus teachers at primary level and 2200 surplus teachers at upper primary level.
- The retention rate at primary level is 99.20%, at elementary level - 98.57%, at secondary level - 96.18% and at senior secondary level – 94.75%.
- The dropout rate is 7.1 % at elementary level, 16.2% at secondary level and 13.1% at senior Secondary level.
- The number of out of school children is 0.4% of total population.
- There are about 4.31% primary, 10.5% upper primary, schools having adverse PTR.
- There are 3608 surplus teachers in the State requires redeployment. The State is taking up exercise of redeployment of excess teachers. This exercise will be completed during 2018-19

Preschool:

Most of the Government schools/ aided schools do not have such preschool arrangements. Discussion with Social Welfare Department is on to integrate Aanganwadis as preschool institution.

National Achievement Survey issues:

- Achievement of students in Class III is below national average in language and Mathematics.
- Achievement of students in Class V is below national average in EVS and Mathematics.

- Achievement of students in Class VIII is below national average in Science, Social Science and Mathematics.
- State must emphasize on improving the learning levels of students in these classes.
- State must provide special attention and prepare a plan of action to improve learning levels in the low performing districts.

Teacher Education Institutions

- As per the scheme 800 (@ 25 per DIET x 32 DIETs) academic posts have to be sanctioned. The State Govt. has sanctioned 756 Academic posts, and 505 posts are filled up, i.e. 37% vacancy.
- As per the scheme, 56 (@ 8 per BITE x 7 BITE) academic posts has to be sanctioned. The State Govt. has sanctioned 56 Academic posts, out of which 36 posts have been filled up, i.e. 23 % vacancy.

5. COMMITMENTS OF THE STATE FOR 2018-19:

- (i) State would document their best practices and initiatives and subsequently upload it on the **SSA Shagun** portal. This would enable the STATE to showcase its successes and would provide a platform for all STATES and UTs to learn from each other.
- (ii) State will undertake positive consolidation of its schools, within the provisions of the RTE Act, with a view to strengthen primary education and for optimum utilization of resources.
- (iii) State will map all the stand alone Government and Government aided primary schools, develop and finalize specific action plans for improving learning outcomes in these schools.
- (iv) The State will rationalize teacher deployment so that there is no single teacher school and all schools have PTR as per norms under the RTE Act, 2009. At the upper primary and secondary level, special emphasis should be laid on maintaining the subject PTR.
- (v) State will recruit headmasters in primary and upper primary schools as per the RTE norms. Given the significant role of a headmaster in school management, direct recruitment (including through limited department exam) of 50% of all headmasters may be considered.

- (vi) State should ensure that children with less than grade level learning competencies are identified and provided learning support and in-school reinforcement. Efforts would be made so that that all children reach the desired grade-appropriate competency level.
- (vii) State would assess its grading under the Performance Grading Index (PGI) developed by the Department and carry out the required governance reforms to improve its grading.
- (viii) State would focus on the aspirational districts to achieve significant improvement in the key performance indicators identified for the same.
- (ix) The guidelines for expenditure on school grant, procurement of sports equipment and library books need to be followed. These need to be kept in mind while utilization of these grants.
- (x) The detailed guidelines on Operation Digital Board need to be followed to utilize the funds approved under the ICT initiatives.
- (xi) State will explore the mechanisms for convergence with other departments especially with the Department of Panchayati Raj for maintenance of school infrastructure, school sanitation and provisioning of drinking water facilities in schools.
- (xii) State should undertake the “Partnership Between Schools” Programme which aims to link schools located in rural areas with private, aided or government schools in urban or semi urban areas. This would help in bringing all students to one common platform and to share experiences and learn from each other.
- (xiii) State will display a gallery of the grade-wise photos of teachers on the school notice board in all elementary schools. The photos would be in a size that is visible and identifiable. This would help in honouring the teachers who are the fulcrum of the education system.
- (xiv) State will complete all the pending civil works in 2018-19.
- (xv) State will ensure inspection and evaluation of all primary and upper primary schools.
- (xvi) State would ensure the implementation of Public Finance Monitoring System (PFMS) up to the last destination i.e., school.
- (xvii) The Annual Report would be submitted to the Department for laying in the Parliament.
- (xviii) State would ensure effective implementation of the RTE Act, 2009.

6 EXPECTED OUTCOME:

In the meeting the following specific outcomes have been agreed to:

- (i) State would document their best practices and initiatives and subsequently upload it on the School Education SHAGUN website. This would enable the UT to showcase its successes and would provide a platform for all States and UTs to learn from each other.
- (ii) For the year 2017-18, State has identified 19582 Out of School Children (OoSC) and it has committed that all will be enrolled in schools during 2018-19.
- (iii) Dropout rate will be reduced at elementary level and secondary level especially for girls.
- (iv) The State has committed to complete the construction works of the previously approved civil work that has yet not started.
- (v) The state has committed to complete the 4330 ICT@ School that has not been implemented.
- (vi) The state is committed to start Vocational education in previously approved 67 schools.
- (vii) The State would fill up the vacancies of teachers and headmasters at all levels.
- (viii) The State will share database of all CWSN children on PMS portal of Samagra Shiksha.
- (ix) State would integrate their MIS on students, teachers and schools with the ShalaKosh software developed by the Department.
- (x) The State will ensure that all commitments under RTE Act, 2009 are fulfilled.
- (xi) The State will revise the district plans as per the approved AWP&B and share with the Department by 15th Aug, 2018.
- (xii) NAS results would be thoroughly analyzed and learning gaps identified. Strategic interventions in pedagogic methodologies and teacher training should be devised to improve the learning outcomes.

7. Total Estimated Budget 2018-19:

After detailed discussion, an outlay of Rs. 283769.33 lakh for the year 2018-19 was estimated as under:-

8. Actual release by GOI during 2018-19:

Against the above estimates, Central Government shall provide to the State Government Rs. 1422.51 crore (Elementary: Rs. 999.34 cr., Secondary: Rs.380.16 cr., TE: Rs.43.01 cr.) as its share. The State would contribute Rs.948.34 crore as its State share matching the above Central share as per the existing fund sharing pattern of Samagra Shiksha.

It is likely that additional funds will be received subsequently during the year. A meeting for considering supplementary releases may, therefore, be held in the month of September- October, 2018.

It is recommended that the State should meet the balance amount from its own including the additional funds devolved under the 14th Finance Commission. As per Section 7(5) of the RTE Act, 2009, the State Government shall after taking into consideration the sum provided by the Central Government above and the mandatory matching State share, provide the balance funds necessary to fulfill the estimate for the implementation of the Act.

The release of funds under the scheme will be further guided by the following conditions:

- (i) State should release/transfer the central share to State implementing Society within 15 days of its receipt in the State treasury.

- (ii) The State share should be released to the State Implementing Society within one month of the release of the central share.
- (iii) All releases by the Centre would be subject to fulfillment of provisions of GFR by the State.
- (iv) The 1st Installment would be released based on provisional utilization certificate for 2017-18 and subject to full release of proportionate State share.
- (v) The second installment would be released only after (a) the proportionate installment of State/UT share has been released; (b) at least 50% expenditure against available funds has been incurred; (c) utilization certificate has been submitted for funds released in the year 2017-18; (d) Audit report has been submitted for the year 2017-18 and (e) Annual Report upto the year 2016-17 has been submitted.

- (i) **Higher Secondary School Science Stream (XI - XII):** 5 schools were approved @Rs.157.15 lakh for upgradation with an estimate of Rs.785.75 lakh. The list of schools is at **Annexure-III**.
- (ii) **Strengthening/ Major repair:** Under strengthening component, 228 boys' toilets and 273 girls' toilets for elementary schools were approved with a total estimate of Rs. 1229.70 lakh. And major repair work for 361 classrooms of 195 Government elementary Schools with a total estimate of Rs. 424.58 lakh was approved. The List of Schools is at **Annexure-IV**
- (iii) 24 Science Lab with equipment, 26 Art and Craft room, 1 Library, 54 boys and 77 girls toilets were approved for govt. secondary schools with a total estimate of Rs. 1351.40 lakh.
- (iv) Under Senior Secondary schools, 5 Science Labs (2 Physics and 3 Biology Labs) with equipments were approved with a total estimate of Rs. 90.25 lakh.
- (v) **Solar Panel for schools:** 16 on grid roof top solar PV system @Rs.3.5 lakh per school with a total estimate of Rs.56.00 lakh was approved. The list is enclosed at **Annexure-V**.

- (vi) **Residential schools/ Hostels:** 03 residential schools with the capacity of 50 students and 09 residential hostels with the capacity of 100 students were approved with a total estimate of Rs.374.80 lakh.
- (vii) **Transport/Escort facility:** Transport/Escort facility was estimated for 17541 children with an estimate of Rs. 933.18 lakh.

II. RTE ENTITLEMENTS

- (i) **Free Uniforms:** Free uniforms for 3035799 children at elementary level were approved with a total estimate of Rs 9107.40 lakh.
- (ii) **Free Textbooks:** Free textbooks for 4478500 children at elementary level were approved with a total estimate of Rs. 14194.94 lakh.
- (iii) **Reimbursement of Fee against 25% admission under Section 12(1) (c) of RTE Act 2009 (Entry Level):** Reimbursement to Private Unaided Schools for 2015-16 was approved with a total estimate of Rs.2769.99 lakh.
- (iv) **Special Training for age appropriate admission of out-of-school children (OoSC) at Elementary Level:** State has identified 19582 out of school children in the age group of 6-14 years. Non- residential. and residential special trainings including the interventions for migrant children have been approved with a total estimate of Rs. 1691.60 lakh.
- (v) **Media and Community Mobilization:-** An outlay of Rs. 469.39 lakh was estimated for 31293 elementary schools @ Rs. 0.015 lakh and Rs. 90.97 lakh has been estimated for 6065 secondary schools .
- (vi) Training of SMC/SDMC members in 15646 elementary school and 3032 secondary schools has been estimated with a total outlay of Rs.560.34 lakh @RS. 0.03 lakh.

III. QUALITY INTERVENTIONS

- (i) **Fund for Quality Improvement:** An outlay of Rs. 3197.19 lakh was estimated for different Quality related interventions including Learning Enhancement Programmes (LEP) at elementary and secondary levels, talent search, remedial teaching, emotional well-being for govt. school, aptitude tests at secondary level, SCOPE project and Mapping skills including shala shidhi and Kala Utsav programme.

- (ii) Yoga Olympiad with a total estimate of Rs.16.00 lakh was approved.
- (iii) Band competition with a total estimate of Rs. 1.00 lakh, Toss program with a total estimate of Rs.47.76 lakh, sports school program for one school @Rs. 96.00 lakh and Model school with a total outlay of Rs.320.00 lakh has been estimated under quality innovative activities.
- (iv) An outlay of Rs. 320.00 lakh has was estimated under POST NAS activities.
- (v) An outlay of Rs.13524.75 lakh for composite school grant as per school was estimated as per enrollment including 10% for swachata program fund. This is to be implemented as per the scheme guidelines.
- (vi) **Libraries:** - An annual library grant was estimated with the total outlay of Rs 623.03 lakh for elementary, secondary and senior secondary schools. The utilization of the funds for books and libraries needs to be in accordance with the detailed guidelines being issued by MHRD. The following points needs to be kept in mind:
- Age appropriate books published by NCERT, NBT, State Government Publications, SCERT may be procured.
 - States/UTs may try to set up Readers' Club in schools in a phased manner with the help of National Centre for Children's Literature (NCCL), a wing of National Book Trust.
 - During the first year, no magazines and newspapers can be procured from the funds meant for library books.
 - States/UTs may constitute a committee to select age appropriate books from NCERT and NBT and to make guidelines for use of libraries including number of periods in the govt. schools.
 - The schools may make provision of Reading Room/Reading Corner/Reading space and two periods in a week may be dedicated as reading periods in school time table.
 - One teacher may be given the additional responsibility of custody of library books, issuing and receiving back of books who in turn may be relaxed from teaching for two periods in a week.
- (vii) An outlay of Rs 377.04 lakh was estimated under **Rashtriya Avishkar Abhiyan (RAA)** for various activities like: Science Exhibition / Book Fair, math kit, science kit, quiz competition, teacher exchange programme for empowerment and Exposure Visits within and outside State.

- (viii) Under Shala Kosh, special project for provision of tablet /IT device for school management including biometric attendance was approved for 30000 schools @ Rs. 0.1 lakh per school with a total estimate of Rs. 3000.00 lakh. The utilization of these funds needs to be in accordance of the detailed Guidelines issued under Operation Digital Board. The following need to be kept in mind, specifically, during procurement:
- a) Inventory of each item will be maintained and the concerned school Principal will be in-charge of ensuring that all hardware and software has been marked as inventory items. The record of ICT inventory, school wise, has to be maintained online and made available to MHRD as and when required.
 - b) States and UTs have to ensure that Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for each hardware item procured under ICT scheme has been entered into.
 - c) In order to ensure that computers installed in the schools are being used, software which indicates when the computers are turned on or off, linked to the State server, must be put in place.
 - d) As per IT Act 2000 it has to be ensured that effective firewalls and appropriate control filters and monitoring software mechanism are installed in all computers in schools. Please consult local NIC for installing a government approved, free firewall.
- (ix) An outlay of Rs. 205.00 lakh was estimated for training of Anganwadi worker and development of training modules cum teaching material for students for supporting pre-school education in 5000 schools @ Rs.0.041 lakh per school.
- (x) Support for sports and physical education for 7432 primary and 5279 upper primary schools with a total estimate of Rs. 719.6 lakh was approved. The utilization of the funds for sports and physical education needs to be in accordance with the detailed guidelines being issued by MHRD. The following points needs to be kept in mind:
- Age appropriate sports equipments for government schools may be procured as per the guidelines to be issued by this Department to the States/UTs. The States/UTs may if they so desire, procure items from beyond this list subject to its actual requirement being certified by the head of school.

- Age appropriate sports activities may be organised in the government schools of States/UTs as per the guidelines to be issued by this Department. Schools may include traditional/regional games of the respective State/Region.
 - For maintaining workable stock position of sports equipments, periodic record may be maintained including workable equipment, repairable equipment, write-off equipment and new items to be purchased to maintain the required stock position.
 - One responsible person/PET/Teacher incharge may be given the responsibility to take care of the equipments and maintaining the stock position of sports equipments in the school.
- (xi) An outlay of Rs 42221.50 lakh was estimated for Academic support through BRC/URC/CRC.
- (xii) An outlay of Rs 3514.25 lakh was estimated for in-service teacher training for class I to XII teachers.
- (xiii) An Outlay of Rs. 351.48 was estimated for Training of resource persons and master trainers.
- (xiv) School leadership training of head teachers/ principal/ RPs was estimated with a total outlay of Rs.312.0 lakh.

IV. STRENGTHENING OF TEACHER EDUCATION:

- (i) An outlay of Rs. 173.60 lakh was estimated for renovation and repair work for 8 DIETs
- (ii) Training of educational Administrators was approved with a total estimate of Rs. 34.18 lakh.
- (iii) An outlay of Rs 150.00 lakh was estimated for capacity building and training of teachers, teacher educators and state officials for use of DIKSHA, Creation and Curation of Digital Teaching Learning Material for uploading on DIKSHA, Content Creation for Energized Textbooks and Creation of online/digital modules for Professional development of teachers.
- (iv) An outlay of Rs 3995.71 lakh was estimated for Salaries of Teacher Educators.
- (v) An outlay of Rs 960.00 lakh was estimated for Program & Activities including Faculty Development.
- (vi) An outlay of Rs 204.80 lakh was estimated for hard ware and software support for 32 DIETS under Technology Support to TEIs. And recurring cost of the 40 DIETS with a total outlay of Rs. 24.00 lakh was estimated.

- (vii) An outlay of Rs 710.00 lakh was estimated for Annual Grant of SCERT (Rs 35 lakh) and DIETs (Rs 640 lakh) and BIETs (Rs. 35 Lakh).
- (viii) **Teachers Salary:** An outlay of Rs. 111921.96 lakh was estimated under teacher salary component, as per the norms of the scheme. Any additionality as per Terms & Conditions for recruitment of teachers in the State is to be borne by the State.

- (i) **Katurba Gandhi Balika Vidhayalaya:** Under KGBV Type -1 an outlay of Rs. 1.50 lakh was estimated for replacement of bedding in 2 KGBV.

- An outlay of Rs. 513.99 lakh was estimated for Self defence training for Girls in 5711 govt. Secondary and Higher Secondary schools @Rs. 0.09 for three months.
 - An outlay of Rs. 633.87 lakh was estimated for 7043 (6 to 8) Elementary schools with girl enrollment @0.09 lakh per school for 3 months.

VI. INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

An outlay of Rs 7430.48 lakh was estimated for various activities for CWSN at elementary, secondary and senior secondary level. The State was asked to share database of all CWSN children on PMS portal of Samagra Shiksha.

VII. VOCATIONAL EDUCATION:

A total outlay of Rs. 355.10 lakh has been estimated under VE. The UT needs to ensure that the admissions under Vocational Education are taken only in the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) compliant courses/job roles. Funding would not be available for the non-compliant courses. The implementation timelines under vocational education may be strictly adhered to. The Assessment and certification of students may be completed in time. Delay and pendency in assessment and certification (if any) may be reported to MHRD.

VIII. MIS: An outlay of Rs. 246.63 lakh was estimated for MIS and activities under ShalaKosh.

IX. PROGRAMME MANAGEMENT: An outlay of Rs. 11727.01 lakh (5% against total outlay) was estimated for Programme Management.

X. There is a spillover of Rs. 37501.94 lakh on account of civil interventions estimated under elementary, Secondary and Teacher education programme in previous years. The State was asked to complete these works in 2018.19. The details of spill-over are at **Annexure-II (a)**.
