The Pr. Secretaries/ Secretaries (Education) of all States, except Chandigarh and Lakshadweep,

Sub: Filling the gaps in availability and functionality of toilets and drinking water facilities in schools – regarding.

Madam/ Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letters of even no. dated 18.4.2018, 26.7.2018, 10.9.2018, 30.11.2018 and 28.8.2019 and letter no. 27-41/2016-EE.16 dated 23.4.2018 requesting for filling up the gaps, if any, as per latest U-DISE data and ensure availability and functionality of boys' and girls' toilets and safe & adequate drinking water facility in all the schools in your State/UT. It was also requested to share an action taken report with this department and upload the status on Shagun portal.

2. I am also directed to refer to this Department's letter no. 27-1/2015-EE.16(Pt.) dated 29.6.2015 and No.F.27-47/2016-EE.16 dated 6.10.2016, requesting to comply with the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009 with respect to provision for separate toilets for boys and girls: and safe & adequate drinking water facility for all children, in every recognized schools including the private and aided schools.

3. The State/UT-wise UDISE++ data, 2018-19 (copy enclosed) indicated gaps in availability and functionality of girls' and boys' toilets and drinking water facility in government schools. Therefore, it is requested to take expeditious action for availability of sanitation and drinking water facilities in schools and ensure that toilets and drinking water facilities in all the schools are functional and available to students and teachers/staff. Action taken in this regard may be intimated to this Department and arranged to be uploaded on Shagun Portal, by 15th February, 2020.
