CBSE schools to celebrate GANIT (Growing Aptitude in Numerical Innovations & Training) Week

To commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr. Srinivasa Aiyangar Ramanujan on 22nd December, 2015, the CBSE has invited all affiliated schools to celebrate GANIT (Growing Aptitude in Numerical Innovations & Training) Week.

For this purpose, the schools have been given several age appropriate activities which may be conducted during the GANIT week. For instance, Mathematics Relay Race for each grade, students may be divided in groups of 5-8 depending upon the class strength. A series of questions may be prepared and students may move ahead in the race only after solving those questions.

Solving Mathematical Puzzles such as solving Rubik's cube and creating magic squares. Interactive Session on Mathematics Interactive activity-based sessions may be organized for students on various topics like Mathematics in nature, Mathematics in architecture, Pascal's triangle, Vedic Mathematics.

Quiz competitions may be organized by schools for each grade based on the various topics that they study in Mathematics

Mathematical games such as Sudoku and Kakuro and other similar activities may also be included as part of the activities. It is expected that such endeavours will reduce the fear of Mathematics and make its study more interesting amongst students.
